This week we have unfortunately had several students choose to bring prohibited items such as water guns and Orbeez/gel pellet guns on campus.

While no student or staff suffered injury or harm from these toys being brought to school, these items are viewed as weapons or potentially dangerous items that disrupt the educational process! These weapons are subject to confiscation and may be turned over to law enforcement. In addition, examples of other items on the prohibited list include:

- Knives
- Guns
- Explosive devices
- Stink bombs
- Pepper spray/mace

Any student found in possession of any of these items will be suspended immediately!

Skyline Education wishes to promote a safe, enjoyable learning environment for our students and staff and in doing so, we are asking for your support and assistance, in making this happen. Please take a moment to talk to students and stress the importance of leaving these items at home.
